**PREVENTING FRAUD** 

Notice to Lodging Parties No. 138 advised of interstate frauds involving the use of illegally obtained certificates of title. Lodging parties were reminded of the importance of verification of the identity of parties to the dealing by the conveyancer, solicitor or representative of the financial institution

Lands Titles Office Proof of Identity (POI) requirements have now been introduced for Applications for Substituted Certificate of Title or Crown Lease, where the applicant is also the certifying party.

This will reduce the risk of a fraudster applying for and receiving a title to land. The title could then be used to mortgage, transfer or otherwise deal with the land.

As the certifying party must be a natural person this policy does not apply to applications made by incorporated bodies such as companies and associations as these must be certified by a solicitor or registered conveyancer.

Applications must be lodged face-to-face with a registration officer on the ground floor of the Lands Titles Office. Every applicant/certifier must attend in person and provide appropriate **original** documents to prove their identity.

The POI framework adopted is based on the 100-point identity checks used by financial institutions under the *Financial Transactions Reports Regulations 1990.* 

The following table provides a guide to acceptable POI documents and the points allocated to each. At least one of the identification documents must incorporate a **photograph of the person.** If this is not possible then another form of validation may be required.
