Forest Property Agreements

This notice replaces that portion of Notice to Lodging Parties No.132 dealing with Forest Property Agreements.

The Forest Property Act 2000 (FPA) was amended by the Forest Property (Carbon Rights) Act 2006¹. This notice now reflects those amendments.

FOREST PROPERTY AGREEMENTS

The FPA allows for two types of agreements to be created:

Forest property (vegetation) agreements

These separate the forest vegetation from the owner of the land (transferor) to another (transferee).

The agreement may reserve the right to take any edible fruits from the forest vegetation to the transferor.

• Forest property (carbon rights) agreements


These separate the ownership of the carbon rights from the vegetation (transferor) to which it relates to another (transferee).

The requirements as to the form and content of the agreement are set out in section 6 of the FPA.

An application to the Registrar-General to note either agreement is to be made on panel form A3 (See Annexure A) with a prefix of AG. The actual agreement must be attached to the application.

A Forest Property Agreement will appear as an endorsement. It may be registered over the whole or portion of the land in a Certificate of Title or Crown Lease. If lodged over portion, a plan must be deposited in the General Registry Office to identify the land to which the agreement relates.

The agreement (or an interest in one) may be transferred, mortgaged or encumbered². Existing panel forms dealing with Encumbrances (ie TE, ME and E2) are to be used. For other dealings, such as Foreclosures, Powers of Sale, Caveats, etc. the existing document and prefixes for non fee simple dealings may be used.

A transaction is ineffective unless consents as required by the FPA are obtained or dispensed with.

The agreement may be varied by agreement between the owner of the land and the owner of the carbon rights and/or forest vegetation³. The application to note the variation can be made on panel form A3 (See Annexure B) with a prefix of VA. The agreement to vary must be attached.

An application to revoke or determine an agreement is to be made on panel form A3 with a prefix of AX. (See Annexure C for suggested wording to be used in "Specify Nature of Application" panel for each scenario)

Any consent required by the Act must be endorsed in the appropriate document and be witnessed.

An application to terminate or discharge by Court Order is to be made on panel form A3 with a prefix of OD. (See Annexure C for suggested wording to be used in "Specify nature of Application" panel.) A copy of the Court Order must to be attached.

Dealings with land, the subject of an agreement, should include the agreement as an encumbrance.

Unlike a lease with a certain time frame agreements with expiration dates will not automatically be deleted or cancelled once that time frame has passed. These will only be deleted when a new CT is to issue or an application to revoke or terminate is received.

A forest property agreement made before the commencement of the *Forest Property* (Carbon Rights) Act 2006 continues as a forest property (vegetation) agreement, with a reservation of edible fruits to the owner of the land.
