## Subscriber Compliance Guidance

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Section 33 of the *Electronic Conveyancing National Law (South Australia) Act 2013* (ECNL) grants the Registrar the authority to conduct a compliance examination to determine whether the Participation Rules have been adhered to or to investigate any suspected or alleged misconduct by a Subscriber.

Under Section 34 of the ECNL, a Subscriber is required to fully cooperate in a compliance examination. Schedule 5 of the Participation Rules outlines the Compliance Examination Procedure.

The Australian Registrars' National Electronic Conveyancing Council (ARNECC) has developed [Common Errors Form](#) to provide additional guidance for Subscribers regarding common errors identified across jurisdictions during Subscriber compliance examinations.

Please see the ARNECC Compliance Examinations [Guidance Note](#) that provides advice to Subscribers on how and when they can expect a compliance examination to be conducted of their compliance with the Version 7 Model Participation Rules.
